



RESOLUTION FOR JOINT PRIMARY

Whereas, the Democratic Party of El Paso County, Texas, and the Republican Party of El Paso County, Texas, desire to enter into a 2026 Joint Primary Election Services Agreement with the El Paso County Election Administrator, as the County Election Officer; and

Whereas, pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 172.126, primary elections in a county may be conducted jointly with approval of the Commissioners Court and the county chair of each political party required to nominate candidates by primary election; and

Whereas, as indicated by their signature below, the El Paso County Democratic Party Chair and the El Paso County Republican Chair, respectively, have each requested and agreed to conducting a joint primary runoff election; and

Whereas, the Commissioners Court of El Paso County, Texas desires to give authorization for a Joint Primary Election Services Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners Court of El Paso, County, Texas, a Joint Primary Services Agreement is authorized by and among El Paso County Democratic Party Chair Michael Apodaca, El Paso County Republican Party Chair Michael Aboud, and El Paso County Election Officer Lisa Wise, for the conduct and supervision of the El Paso County Joint Primary Election on March 3, 2026 and any resulting Primary Runoff Election on May 26, 2026.
