The El Paso County Elections Department will continue to deputize walk-ins in our office located at 500 E. San Antonio Ave., Suite #314, El Paso, Texas 79901 every Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., excluding holidays and election cycle. Groups of a minimum of 25 attendees requesting a private training must contact the Elections Department two weeks in advance at (915) 273-3597 or m.covarrubias@epcountytexas.gov.

Note: After every voter registration deadline, no trainings will be available for public and private groups until after the election. Request for private trainings will resume five business days after every election.

Volunteer Deputy Registrar appointments made during the 2025-2026 cycle will expire on December 31, 2026. By Texas Law, all Volunteer Deputy Registrar appointments will expire on December 31st of even-numbered years.
